OVERVIEW	Capella Castlemartyr will bring Capella Hotels and Resorts to Ireland upon its debut this August. Located in eastern County Cork, Ireland, in the bucolic country village of Castlemartyr, the resort will be made up of a grand, fully restored manor house adjacent to the dramatic ruins of a thousand-year-old castle. The 220-acre estate, just minutes from the ruggedly beautiful southern coast of Ireland, are home to a historic chapel, the tomb of the third Earl of Cork and the vast greenery of Mitchell's Woods.
SETTING	Capella Castlemartyr is a 20-minute drive from the center of Cork City and the newly expanded Cork International Airport. The resort is ideally situated between the East Cork towns of Midleton and Youghal, and is just 10 minutes from Ballycotton, the ruggedly beautiful shark and fishing harbor and tourist trail.
HISTORY	The castle, from which the village takes its name, was built in 1210 by the knights of Richard Earl de Clare and belonged first to the Knights Templar. Maurice Fitzgerald and then Earl of Desmond, the third Earl of Cork, took possession of the estate.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Capella Castlemartyr will host 103 guestrooms and suites ranging from 500-square feet to more than 3,000-square feet in the Presidential Suite. The hotel's range of guestrooms include one- and two-bedroom suites.

DINING

The cuisine of Capella Castlemartyr will be prepared using fresh ingredients from the estate's herb garden and local farmers and their markets. The main dining room, **Bell Tower**, will seat up to 30 people while three additional intimate dining rooms will host up to 10, 15 and 20 people each. In addition, 24-hour room service will be offered.

The **Knight's Bar** will serve as the resort's social focal point. Its grand bar, fireplace, baby grand piano, martini trolley service and fully restored Rococo ceiling create a cozy, sophisticated ambiance.

GOLF

The 18-hole **Golf Course at Castlemartyr** will be a highlight of the resort experience. The challenging and visually pleasing inland-links course is designed by Ron Kirby who designed, among others, Old Head of Kinsale and Dromoland Castle in his nearly five-decade career.

SPA AND FITNESS

Auriga at the Capella Castlemartyr hotel is a 16,000-square foot wellness, spa and fitness center with 10 treatment rooms, a spa café and a yoga and Pilates studio. A vitality pool, full-ozone swimming pool, steam room, sauna, private VIP Suites and amenities provided by The Organic Pharmacy will offer superior remedies for modern stressors.

ACTIVITIES

Capella Castlemartyr allows guests to experience Irish culture with activities tailored to each and every guest's preference. A **Capella Concierge** can arrange, for example, everything from boating with a local fisherman to secure the "catch of the day," visits to nearby farmer's markets and outings to the local beekeeper to procure honey for tea. Private readings by well-known authors and Irish dance and music performances in the gardens can also be arranged.

MEETINGS AND EVENTS

A function room and three board rooms will serve small executive board meetings for up to 64 people.

Capella Castlemartyr will cater to small scale weddings of up to 64 people, with larger affairs requiring a resort buy out.
